MINUTES OF THE October 7, 2009 MEETING

Meeting called to order at 7:05: p.m. by President Pete Hull

Approval of Minutes: Members received minutes from the September 9, 2009 meeting via email or in the mail.

Motion: Approve the minutes of September 9, 2009 meeting. Moved, seconded and approved by voice vote.

Director's Report-Rick Moffit-not present- Working with the band rehearsing.

Fundraising – Karla Hull – Karla introduced Renee who was present to give the opportunity for parents to sell Pampered Chef. All proceeds goes to individual band fees. She had catalogs and order forms to hand out. Can order online and get the credit as well. On the address line put the band members name and your band member will get credit for the sale. 13-15% of the profit goes to the BPA the rest goes to individual band fees. All orders due by October 21. She needs the order forms completed thoroughly. Great for gifts.

Amazon has invited us back to wrap presents this year. We need atleast 5 persons per shifts. First 45 minutes of your first shift you receive training. The other shifts you get to work straight through. The first \$5 of each shift per person goes to the BPA. Remaining profit goes towards individual band fees.

Office Report-Cindra Marandola - We need chaperones for every one of the trips coming up (except Clovis). We need 12 chaperones per trip to ride the buses. Even if you don't volunteer to chaperone, you can help the chaperones feed the bands and get them dressed and ready to go. Cindra passed around sign up list for chaperoning and for pushing pit at each contest. We need 12 people to push the pit this year. Mr. Moffit would like to win the pit crew award because McQ has never won it. Dan will work on that. Cindra thanked everyone who paid their fees. She sent out receipts recently. She still needs some Emergency Medical Forms turned in prior to the trip on Saturday. There are currently 30 band members that haven't turned them in yet.

Uniform Committee – Jean Zordell/Diane Wood – not present – Cindra reported that the drum majors will be regular uniform, guard in costumes and the band in the uniform at the football game Friday. We will load the uniforms into the trailer after the football game on Friday night.

Treasurer's Report – Mary Devine reviewed the report. She went over the Bank of America and Wells Fargo accounts debits and deposits. Mary went over receipts turned in today. Mary asked for receipts or deposits. She found a discrepancy of a check for \$1323 out of the Bank Of America account in February. She doesn't know what it is for and she has requested a copy of the check from the bank to verify what it was for. She will report what it is at the next meeting. Two outstanding checks – one for insurance for Reno Rodeo and one for Peterbuilt for the rental of the semi for Rose Parade. She has called Peterbuilt to see why it hasn't clear and Trisha Watson will check into the Reno Rodeo check.

She wants to give the extra hamburger patties to the football boosters because they were so great to us at Extravaganza. **Motion: To give the hamburger patties to the football boosters. Moved, seconded, and approved by voice vote.**

Water Wagon – Sandra Casey Smith – not present –

Pit Crew – no pit duties for football game. He needs several dads to help load the truck on Saturday at 12:30.

Old Business:

Extravaganza Report– very well. Mr. Moffit was very happy with how the event was run. Mary is still collecting receipts and will report on the profit as soon as possible.

Storage container – Pete found one for \$2600 for a used one plus fee for hauling away the old container. **Motion: To purchase the storage container.** Cindra asked if we have enough money to pay a driver and rent a semi (if needed) for Clovis. She suggested that we wait until after the season incase we need those funds for these items. We need to replace the trailer before the winter weather.
