Other sections will be assigned the future car washes. Percussion concert – Little Lancer percussion ensemble concert on May 12. Fine Arts Dessert Night May 14– 5:30-8:30. Still need volunteers. Contact Donna Keislar to sign up. May 16 band plays at Aces Game. Tickets to the game cost \$5 students and \$7 everyone else through Mr. Moffit. The band will play the National Anthem. Wear Band shirt. May 17 Spring Concert with a Bake Sale. May 25 Band Banquet. Parents are assigned food to bring. The band will play at Graduation but Mr. Moffit will be out of town. The Choir and orchestra directors will direct the band. Attendance at graduation is mandatory. Fiesta Bowl Field Competition is tentatively scheduled on Dec. 30 and the Parade is Dec. 31. No idea of cost at this time. Applications for the College scholarship that the BPA sponsors were submitted by senior members of the band. ON May 24 a board meeting is scheduled. May 17 at the Spring Concert at 6:30 a committee will decide who will receive the scholarship. The winner will be announced at the Band Banquet. The City of Reno July 4th parade was cancelled. The band will attend the Graeagle parade on July 4th instead.
